



# INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR THE PFK03

## FRAME ASSEMBLY KIT

The PFK03 Frame assembly kit will help you to assemble rectangular picture frames to a high standard, quickly and easily.

The kit consists of our Frame Clamp, Vee Nailer, Frame leveller and a selection of Framing Hardware.

To use this kit you need 4 pieces of framing moulding cut to length and at 45 degrees.

#### METHOD FOR ASSEMBLING A PICTURE FRAME

1. Take 2 pieces of moulding which will form a corner and place them in the Frame Clamp with the decorated side uppermost so that the flat face is on the bottom.

If you are using glue to give strength to the joint then this should be added sparingly to one of the 2 pieces before fixing in the Frame Clamp.

2. Adjust the 2 pieces of moulding so that the joint is tight and the 2 profiles line up.

Tighten the clamp so as to hold the 2 pieces firmly. Turn the Frame Clamp over and check that the bottom faces of the moulding are tight together. (See Fig. 1). Do not overtighten.

- 3. Select a wedge (Vee nail) and locate it on the Vee Nailer magnet with the sharp end facing down. (See Fig. 2)
- 4.Place the Frame Clamp on a protective surface with the decorated side facing down. This will mean that the bottom of the joint will face upwards, ready to receive the wedge (Vee nail)
- 5. Using a hammer, (not supplied), tap the wedge (Vee nail) into the joint face, keep it central to the line of the joint. The wedge (Vee nail) should be fully inserted and flush with the surface of the joint.
- 6. On wider mouldings more than 1 wedge may be inserted along the joint for added strength.

#### 7. Repeat for the other 3 corners

#### TTP

Try to use flat faced mouldings. If you use more complicated shaped mouldings, you may have to place a support underneath the lowest part of the moulding whilst inserting the wedge. (Vee nail)

### USING THE FRAME LEVELLER

When you hang the picture frame on the wall, place the Frame Leveller on top of the frame and adjust the frame so that the bubble is in the middle of the Frame Leveller lines. (See Fig.3)
