

Replacing a motor on W691 or W692 Dust Extractor

Identify which model you have: Model A has 4 terminals on the switch and 2 wires from the motor. Model B has 5 terminals on the switch and 4 wires from the motor.

All replacement motors have 4 wires.

<u>Instructions for Model A - Using KJD12 switch</u>

Blue wire from plug - Switch terminal 1 Brown wire from plug - Switch terminal 3 Green / Yellow from plug - Earth point on motor body

Blue wire from motor - Switch terminal 2 White wire (either one) from motor - Switch terminal 4

Brown wire from motor - Other White wire from motor

<u>Instructions for Model B - Using KJD17B switch</u>

Blue wire from plug - Switch terminal 13 Brown wire from plug - Switch terminal 23 Green /Yellow from plug - Earth point on motor body

Blue wire from motor - Switch terminal 14 Brown wire & White wire (either one) from motor - Switch terminal 24

Other White wire from motor - Switch terminal A1 (Remote Trip)
